Meeting called to order at 7:10 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

Attendance: 12

Secretary's report: The Minutes from April 4, 2018, were summarized by Robin. Vickie Kusch motioned to approve, Steve Piraino seconded.

Vickie collected for the 50/50 raffle.

Old Business:

- Webmaster: The website is up for renewal and will be renewed for two years. Steve Piraino asked about the pop-up on trail conditions that is on our site. Steve indicated that once the pop-up is on the screen, you can't do anything to get rid of it. Dave will look into it.
- Dues: Membership dues are due now. Please pay them soon.
- Trail Master: Dan was absent. Craig discussed the property across from Bradford's being developed. At this time, there isn't enough information to know what's happening.
- Trail setup: It will be Sunday, November 4, at 9:00 a.m. The rain date will be Sunday, November 11, at 9:00 a.m. Meet at the storage unit on Hwy. E. Lunch will be at Eagle Springs Pub this year. The club will pay for the meal, but drinks are on your own.
- County: The County is getting rid of the insurance benefit from AWSC, currently valued at \$3,000. Apparently, there were too many claims for them to continue offering it. The AWSC website has trail pass information if you would like to check yours. They are charging \$1.50 per transaction for all members renewing online, so we will continue to submit ours in batches rather than single transactions.

- Donations: If anyone has a charity they'd like the club to donate to, please let Craig know. We will review the list of charities we contributed to last year. Craig read a letter from the UW-Platteville Clean Snowmobile Challenge indicating the winners of last year's participants. The Mukwonago Food Pantry sent a letter asking for donations.
- Survey: The board will finalize our survey for the membership at our next meeting and have it sent to the membership before the next meeting.
- KM Days: Robin summarized the results of KM Days and conveyed a huge thank you to all who volunteered their time. Our profit this year was \$1,178.00. She also indicated that we would like to purchase a grill for future KM Days for better reliability and to make it easier to move around. We will keep our eyes open for a good deal.
- Club Trip 2019: Our block of rooms is reserved until November 20 at Gateway. The club trip will be January 24-27.
- Next meeting: We will have snacks at the October and November meetings.

New Business:

- Snow show: October 12-14. Steve Shaffer suggested forfeiting our time slot for selling county tickets. It was nearly unanimous in agreement. We will still need a sign for the booth representing our club.
- State Workshop: The state workshop will be October 26-28 at Chula Vista Resort in Wisconsin Dells. Our club will cover the cost of two members to attend. Please let Craig or a board member know if you are interested.
- Fall Outing: This will be on October 20 at Craig's house. Further information will be forthcoming.
- Fundraiser: We will need to make a decision soon as to what our fundraiser will be, when it will be, and where it will be.
- Hay Days: This is this weekend September 8-9 in North Branch, MN. Steve Piraino and Craig Keys are going if anyone else is interested.
