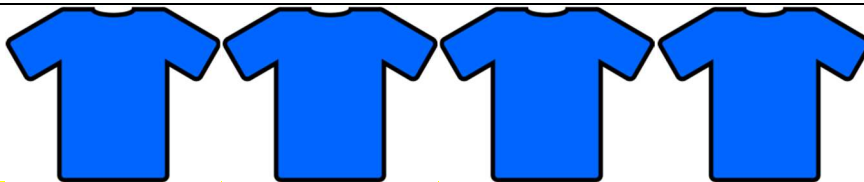

Minutes - Kettle Moraine Riders Snowmobile Club  
Tuesday, April 3, 2018  
Sideliners, North Prairie, WI

Meeting called to order at 7:04 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

Attendance: 17

Secretary's report: The Minutes were in the March newsletter. Steve Shaffer motioned to approve, Vickie seconded.

Motioned to accept by Dave Dill, seconded by Kim Zipperich.

Craig would like an audit sometime over the summer. Carter and Karen Keys volunteered to do the audit.

Board Member report: The Board discussed a permanent location for our monthly meetings. We will talk to Stephanie about this possibility. New brochures and business cards will be printed up, once we have our location secured. A vote was taken, and we will continue to have our meetings here.

Membership numbers are down from last year. The Board will put together a survey asking about participation, what people look for in a club, how they would like to help. Karen said she read that about 17 Walworth County clubs disbanded due to lack of members. Dave Douglas asked if the State of WI would allow us to get the names of registered snowmobilers to see how many are in the area but not a member of a club. We're hoping to have the survey out in late August or September.

Old Business:

- County: Craig went to the county meeting. We sold roughly \$65 worth of county tickets, and we'll receive \$0.50 for each ticket we sold. They are still working on getting our trails funded. At this point, we may have to pay to have our trails groomed and mowed.
- Trailmaster: Trail takedown will be Sunday, April 15. Meet at the storage shed at 9:00 a.m. Highway cleanup will be Sunday, April 22. Meet on Sprague at Hwy. NN at 9:00 a.m. April 22 is also the raindate for trail takedown. Dan read an email from the Wisconsin DNR - they have developed a master plan for nine large properties. On April 16 from 4-7, there will be a public open house at Parkview Middle School in Mukwonago. The plan will be on display and they will address questions. A few members expressed interest in stopping in.

- Webmaster: Nothing new.
- Eagle Business Association: We will be sending them \$80 for our ad in their brochures.
- Fundraiser: Overall, it was a successful event. Our profit for that day was \$2,956.04. Thanks to all who helped and all who attended! Thank you notes will be sent to the sponsors.
- Elections: Everyone who was a board member remains on the board. Dan Rydeski received a gift card as Snowmobiler of the Year.
- Club Dinner: April 28 is the date. The venue is to be determined.
- Club Trip 2019: Our block of rooms is reserved until November 20 at Gateway. The club trip will be January 24-27.
- Brewers Game: Robin sent out an email about dates for an outing. Please reply if you are interested.
- Blue Ribbon Coalition is looking for donations. We are not giving them a donation at this time.
- Eagle Recreation Dept. is asking for a donation in the form of advertising for their booklets. A business-card size ad is \$65. There was no interest in advertising at this time.
- Kettle Moraine Days: June 22-24. Watch for an email from Robin with further information and available time slots to volunteer a couple of hours of your time.
- ATV Club: Steve Shaffer indicated we do not need to have an organized club as we have no trails around us. If we did a ride, we would need coordination for camping, where to go, trails to hit for mud, etc. Vickie indicated that Tomahawk has a very nice campground and good trails.
