Meeting called to order at 7:12 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

Attendance: 16

Secretary's report: The January Minutes were in the newsletter. Steve Shaffer motioned to approve, Vickie Kusch seconded.

Board Member report: No meeting was held in January.

Old Business:

- The Monches Youth Ride was canceled due to lack of snow.

- County meeting will be February 14.
- Trailmaster: Trails are closed. Trails may possibly be open by Friday or Saturday. Jim Kilpatrick has been panning the Eagle trails and the forest. Walworth and Jefferson County has also been panned.
