Club membership dues has now increased from \$30.00 to \$40.00 as of December 1<sup>st</sup>.

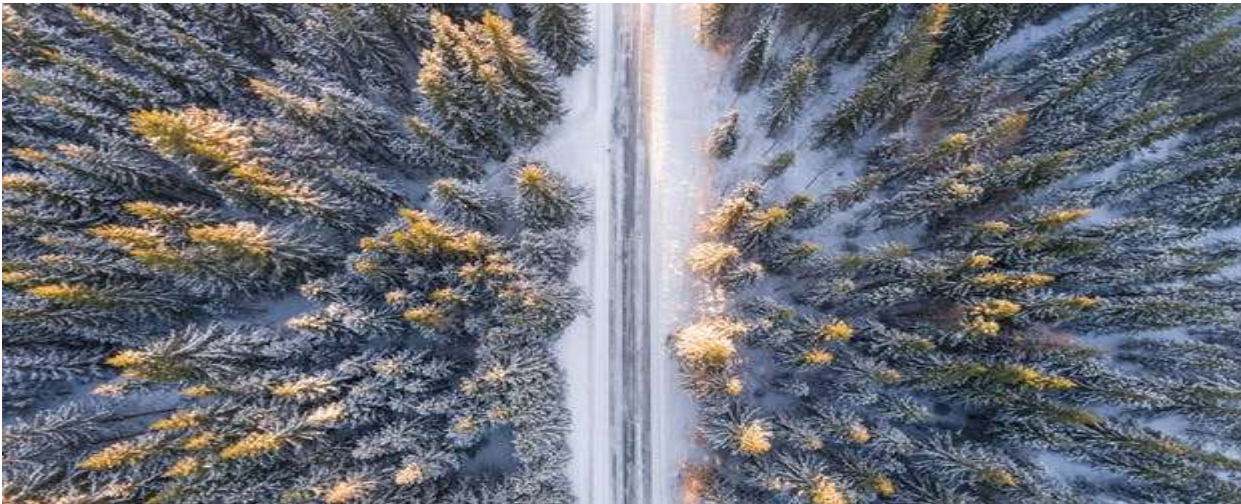
## Communication

# Minutes - Kettle Moraine Riders Snowmobile Club

Tuesday, January 2, 2018  
Sideliners Pub - North Prairie, WI

Meeting called to order at 7:08 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

Attendance: 25

Secretary's report: The December Minutes were in the newsletter. Jim Kilpatrick motioned to accept, Dane Kilpatrick seconded.

Motion to accept made by Karen Johnson, seconded by Dave Dill.

Correspondence: We received a thank-you letter from the Mukwonago Food Pantry for our food and monetary donations. We received a letter from the Blue Ribbon Coalition thanking us for our donation, and they also informed us our membership had expired. Craig asked Steve P. whether he knew anything about this membership from the time he was President, but he did not. It was decided to donate annually without becoming members.

Board Meeting: No Board meeting last week.

County News: Dan and Craig went to the County Christmas party. Craig picked up maps to be delivered and for the members to take. February 3 is the Youth Ride at Monches. There is a safety class 8:00 a.m.-noon on January 27 and February 3 at Brandybrook Community Center in Waukesha. Craig still has county raffle tickets available to sell or purchase.

Website: Nothing new on the website. Dave has KMR clothing available.

Someone from the Adaptive Community Approach program reached out to Karen Keys. He was wondering whether we could coordinate our club to take disabled people out for snowmobile rides during the day any Monday-Friday. Karen told him that the majority of members do not have two-up sleds, plus the majority of members work Monday-Friday during the day. Karen forwarded his information to the county to see whether other clubs would be interested. Jim Kilpatrick said that it would have to be in a field rather than on a trail and stated that their group would have to have their own liability coverage. Dave Buetow suggested that a groomer ride might be a safer alternative.

Winter Fundraiser: Karen has plenty of tickets that need to be sold. Dates will be chosen to sell at a couple of storefronts. The committee should plan to meet an hour prior to the meeting next month.

Trailmaster: There was a downed line by Red Brae. Dan called WE Energies and they sent someone out, but it wasn't their line. Dan ended up moving it off the trail himself once he knew it was low voltage. The second brushing on December 9 and 10 had six people each day. As this was after a wind storm, there was quite a bit of debris to be picked up. The first brushing was for \$1,293, and the brushing on the 9th and 10th was for \$447. This will be turned into the county, which then gets turned into the state for reimbursement. It will be our biggest brushing check yet. Jim Kilpatrick said that the Tucker machine has a new drag on it which will help keep it on the trail. Craig explained that it does not sound as though the North Prairie trail will go through, but a final decision hasn't been made.

50/50 raffle: Vickie walked around selling raffle tickets.

New Business: Nominations for President, Secretary, two board members, and Snowmobiler of the Year will be held at the February 6 meeting. Voting will take place at the March meeting.

The Suburban Sno-Hawks will hold their 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Snowmobile race at Big Bend Village Park on Saturday, February 3, at 10:00 a.m.

Carter is hosting his 6<sup>th</sup> annual Shindig on Saturday, January 27, unless his baby is born before that. It starts at 1:00.

Club Trip: Craig and Karen would like to have a head count for Thursday night of the club trip. Watch for further emails. Craig asked whether we should pre-book Gateway for the original weekend we usually go while we are up there. It was agreed that we should do that.

Motion to adjourn by Jim Kilpatrick, seconded by Clinton Kilpatrick. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
