Minutes - Kettle Moraine Riders Snowmobile Club
Tuesday, March 6, 2018
Sideliners, North Prairie, WI

Meeting called to order at 7:06 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

One new member has joined. He is Ron Schnable from Eagle, WI.

Attendance: 17

Secretary's report: The February Minutes were in the newsletter. Karen Johnson motioned to approve, Jim Kilpatrick seconded.

Board Member report: No meeting was held in February.

Old Business:

- County: Next Wednesday, March 14, is the drawing for the raffle. They have raffle prizes and a dinner for \$5. Craig has county tickets available for purchase. Last year we received a check for \$32.50 from last year's sale of county tickets. Youth bowling will be at the Pioneer Bowl in Richfield from 1-4 on Sunday, April 8. This is to replace the youth ride that was canceled due to lack of snow. Craig reported that 48,713 \$10 trail passes were sold. There was not a final count of the \$30 trail passes. Replacement stickers are available if you have a portion of the ticket still intact. The county site should have our fundraiser event on their website
- Trailmaster: Trails were open for four days, from February 9-13. There was a lot of traffic and minimal issues. Dan repaired a few signs. Tentative date of Sunday, April 15, for trail takedown. Meet at the storage unit at 9:00 a.m. Highway cleanup Sunday, April 22, which coincides with Earth Day. Meet at 9:00 a.m. at Sprague and NN. It is also the raindate for the trail takedown. We should receive a brushing check in May for about \$2,400 for our work in the forest. We received an invoice for trail mowing. Jim Kilpatrick explained that they have to report where mowing is done and in which county, so hours are marked toward each club when it's done. Grooming of our trail system is still able to be attributed to the forest, but at some point, grooming of our trails will be invoiced to our club. We are still working towards having our trails funded.
- Webmaster: Dave asked for club trip pictures to post.
- Blue Ribbon Coalition: We received our membership card for 2019. We have been members since 2002.
- ACSA: On the county website, there was an article about what the ACSA is doing.

- Fundraiser: Robin updated. We have a lot of tickets left to sell. We will be selling tickets at Sideliners during their St. Patrick's Day and March Madness celebration on Saturday, March 17. Our meat raffle event will be March 24 from 1 to 5. We will have multiple meat raffles throughout the day, and at 5:00 we will have our drawing for our main raffle. Please plan on joining us and help support your club.
- Club Trip 2019: Our block of rooms is reserved until November 20 at Gateway. The club trip will be January 24-27.

New Business:

- Brewers Game: Robin will send an email out listing a few dates to choose from for our annual outing.
- Kettle Moraine Days: This event will be here before we know it. The dates are June 22-24. Please watch for emails looking for volunteers to help with this fundraiser.
- Club Dinner: The date for our annual club dinner is April 28. It was suggested that we have dinner at Rushing Waters. Brookwood Inn was suggested as a backup. Robin will contact both restaurants for pricing/menu and follow up in an email.
- Steve Shaffer discussed the possibility of adding a sub-group for ATV riding for the off months of snowmobiling. There seemed to be interest within the group as a number of members currently own ATVs. Steve will get more information and send it out.
- Ballots were passed around for elections. Dave Douglas and Tim Arquette tallied the votes.
