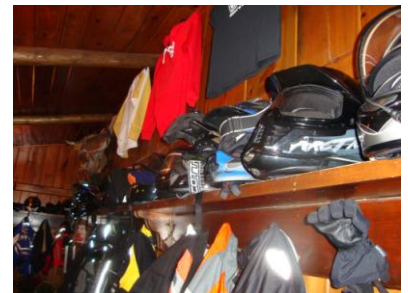
Our club meetings will now start at 7:00 pm. Meeting location stays the same – Summer’s Saloon in Eagle.
