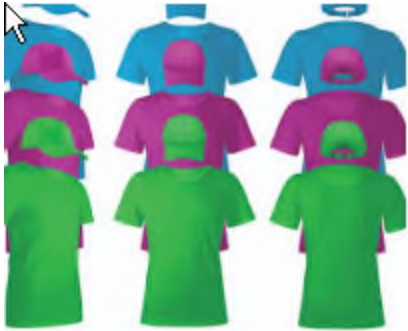

Minutes - Kettle Moraine Riders Snowmobile Club  
Tuesday, December 4, 2018  
Sideliners, North Prairie, WI

Meeting called to order at 7:07 p.m. by President Craig Keys.

Attendance: 26

New Members: Andrew Straley and Chase Stoeger, friends with Kilpatricks. Andy helped with trailbrushing on Sunday.

Secretary's report: The Minutes from November 6, 2018, were in the newsletter. Dave Dill motioned to approve, Vickie Kusch seconded.

Motion to accept by Dave Douglas , Kim Zipprich seconded. Vickie collected for the 50/50 raffle.

Board Meeting: We renewed our Blue Ribbon Coalition membership. Insurance was paid. By-law language will be updated at the next meeting. With regard to the survey, there will be a couple of items that we will try to work on the remainder of this season.

Webmaster: Website should be up to date.

Clothing: Dave Douglas brought clothing along if anyone was interested in purchasing.

Trailmaster: Trail set-up a month ago was attended by 15 people. No issues with putting them in. They are ready to go. All trail setup is in the SNARS system for Waukesha County. Road crossing signs have been ordered. We have official trail numbers that match the map for the first time. The forest is partially complete. Dan is hoping to get out there as soon as there's snow. He replaced some of the beat-up signs with new ones. Please use the trail hotline numbers for each of the counties. Numbers are on the website and on the back of the club's business cards. There is a chance that our club's trails could be funded by next year. The state and county will go throughout

the trail system and rate our trails. We have a contract with the Kettle Moraine State Forest with 43.3 miles for our club to maintain. We will be paid \$300 per mile for this. Our first forest brushing was this past Sunday. The DNR was also there to point out the areas that really needed work. They are open to us bringing a bulldozer in if necessary. About a dozen people showed up, despite the really lousy weather. They were able to accomplish 3-4 hours of brushing. There will be an additional brushing this Sunday. Meet at 10:00 a.m. at the Ottawa parking lot on Hwy. ZZ and Waterville Road. Dan brought maps for the group to take. Dan offered a big thank you to those that came this past Sunday. The trails get better every year due to our efforts. Jim asked about getting signs for the forest as they are in really bad shape. Dan will talk to Harold about that. Jim asked if the DNR has their own signs, but Dan is not sure. Dan will talk to Don about that. Jim said the Sno-Cat is ready to go as soon as there is snow. The tractor will be used to mow this Sunday from Horserider's south.

County: The County Christmas party is at the VFW in Okauchee on Wednesday, December 12. We will be taking a raffle basket. The meeting is at 7:30. Everyone is welcome to attend. Scholarship deadline is January 1. Get ahold of Craig or check out the county site for further information. The trail maps should be available at that time as well. Commercial sponsorship was discussed. Waukesha County has five businesses that support the AWSC. They asked members to recommend businesses to help sponsor. It's \$45 for a regular membership and \$90 for a premier membership. If a club signs anyone, they will get back \$10 for a regular membership or \$20 for premier.

Donations: The Lion's Club requested money or donations to send items to the troops. They will collect this Saturday from 8-12. This year they are looking to get funds to purchase a tracked wheelchair for an Iraq war veteran that lives in our community. Jim Kilpatrick motioned we donate to both. Karen Keys clarified donating \$100 for postage and \$100 for the chair. Vickie seconded.

Club Trip 2019: There are 17 rooms that have been booked.

January meeting: Nick from Road Track & Trail has offered to host a meeting and provide pizzas and beer. He will also offer a helmet to be raffled off that night. The consensus was to hold it there on January 8. Craig will talk to Stephanie at Sideliners and Nick at RT&T. A reminder will be sent out.

Fundraiser: Our meat raffle event is March 16 at Eagle Springs Pub. Other items will also be raffled. Raffle tickets are available. Anyone is welcome to help at the event and to sell tickets. First prize \$500, second prize chainsaw and accessories, third prize GoPro, fourth prize Stihl blower, fifth prize \$100. Karen is asking our group to sell 1200 tickets between now and our event in March.

Facebook: Dave Dill has been updating the Facebook group and asked for people to post if they're out riding.

The winner of \$54.50 in the 50/50 raffle was Andy Straley.

Motion to adjourn by Jim Kilpatrick, Karen Johnson seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m. The club then enjoyed pizza, appetizers, and cookies for their Christmas celebration.
